KENNEDY LAKE

Our tour begins with a safety briefing and introduction to our adventure. Your guide will give instruction on the canoe and will talk to you about safety before we depart for Kennedy Lake and the Clayquot Sound. We'll take a bus ride, stopping briefly in Port Alberni for refreshment before arriving on the shores of Kennedy Lake and our launch point for our flotilla of canoes. We take in the wild backcountry as we paddle quietly along Knnedy Lake, following the shoreline, beneath an old trestle bridge to our overnight camping spot on a wild, secluded beach. After a hearty meal, we may be lucky enough for clear skies and a show of stars that cannot be beaten.

The following morning, we get on the water early and continue the length of Kennedy Lake towards Clayquot Sound. We will explore hidden coves, find picturesque beaches and small islands along the way. We will stop for lunch and a swim before finishing our paddle back to our campground for our second night.

On our final morning, we have a good cooked breakfast before striking camp and paddling back to our launch point, where we will be met by the Elk Bay bus. After loading our equipment and the canoes, we head back to Nanaimo for departures.

Kennedy Lake has an abundance of wildlife including Eagles, Otters, Bear and Wolves. Please bring your cameras!
